## Woikoski Hevospalvelukeskus



Woikoski Hevospalvelukeskus (Woikoski Equestrian Centre) operates on what used to be Mattila Farm. The farm has been owned by Woikoski Oy since the 1930s.

Originally an experimental cultivation farm, Mattila Farm stood as an example of farms of its time. The farm was used to test various experimental cultivation methods, including the cultivation of sugar beet. The farm developed into a village hub with mills. Many villagers picked sugar beet as their first summer job.

Over time, the farm fell into disrepair, but a major renovation project began in 2006. The project began with the lakeside farm building, where the roof was in poor condition. Owner Clas Palmberg's then-girlfriend and now wife, Sari, suggested replacing the roof, and that marked the start of the extensive project. Against all of Clas' protests, Sari had brought her horses to the stable. Clas agreed on two conditions: the renovation shouldn't cost too much or take too long. Years later, the farm is now home



to a successful equestrian centre. It encompasses two stables, a year-round indoor arena, and an equine rehabilitation centre. The resort offers accommodation services, two restaurants, a range of activities, and the Woikoski Car Museum.

Sari's never-ending curiosity about equine wellbeing is behind the Equestrian Centre's operations. The point of departure for Sari was her own horses' wellbeing, and she wanted to offer the same for other people's horses, too.

## Water treadmill



The water treadmill is a safe form of rehabilitation for horses recovering from injury. Alternatively, utilising water resistance offers effective training for sport horses.

Aqua walking reduces strain on the joints, improves muscle tone and strength, straightness and suppleness, and promotes respiratory and cardiovascular activity. The stepless adjustment of speed, gradient and water depth can change the focus of the session depending on the horse's needs.



## StiRoom salt room

The StiRoom salt room is a natural treatment method that offers health benefits without any drawbacks. Use of the salt room reduces dependence on courses of medicine, such as antibiotics. It offers an entirely natural treatment method that also improves the horse's performance, oxygen uptake, and endurance.

StiRoom treatment at the Equestrian Centre reduces pain, swelling and muscle cramps, and alleviates the harmful effects of rheumatism and sprains and strains. StiRoom revitalises the body, accelerates recovery, and prevents stress. The infrared sauna warms the horse's muscles and relaxes them to promote recovery.

The treatment prevents several illnesses and significantly reduces the risk of injury. A combination of the salt room and infrared sauna improves the immune system and prevents conditions such as colds, asthma, and allergies.

Additionally, the StiRoom improves skin health by disinfecting, moisturising and nourishing the skin.

## Vitafloor vibration plate and solarium



The Vitafloor vibration plate is equipped with an equine solarium and used for injury prevention and rehabilitation, muscle maintenance and development, and to accelerate recovery from strain. Also suitable for horses on stall rest or restricted movement.

This form of treatment increases muscular flexibility and strengthens the bones. The Vitafloor vibration plate promotes circulation throughout the body, shortens recovery time after tendon injury, increases bone density, symmetrically strengthens the back muscles, prevents colic and promotes hoof growth.



## EQ Cryo equine cabin

Cryotherapy is used in horses to e.g. accelerate recovery after surgery, injury, or physical strain thanks to a rise in endorphins and adrenaline. The treatment improves immunity and heightens performance.

Cryotherapy is used for various muscle pains, arthritis, skin complaints, more effective recovery from injuries, and for general wellbeing. Tests indicate that horses benefit from the same health effects of cryotherapy as humans do.





## Cryonic neurocryostimulation



The device can be used to treat muscle stiffness, strains and sprains, inflammation, joint pain, and skin ulcers. Neurocryostimulation can be used to accelerate recovery from strain and to prevent and treat sports injuries.

The benefit of neurocryostimulation is its rapid effect. The treatment relaxes the muscles and causes thermal shock, which initiates a natural healing response.

Neurocryostimulation can be used to rapidly alleviate pain, speed up the metabolism, relax the muscles and muscle sheaths, reduce swelling, promote fluid circulation, improve movement, and promote wound healing.

Neurocryostimulation can be used as a primary treatment or to supplement other treatment methods.



## Laser

Laser therapy is used to treat various types of pain and inflammation, to improve circulation, and to locally boost immunity.

Typical applications for laser therapy are arthritis, tendon and ligament injuries, fractures, wounds, strains, hoof cracks, and equine thrush. Laser therapy is also used as a preventive form of treatment. It is particularly suited to treating locomotor system issues (muscle, tendon, and joint complaints).

Laser therapy promotes tissue recovery and regeneration, alleviates pain and reduces inflammation. It can be used during the acute injury phase as well as to treat chronic complaints. Laser therapy promotes the injury healing process and often shortens recovery time.





## Shockwave



Shockwave therapy is a safe and effective method of treatment for muscle and tendon complaints. The key aims of the treatment are to alleviate pain and to preserve or restore range of motion.

Shockwave therapy can be used as a standalone treatment or in combination with other treatment methods, and has shown benefits in the treatment of problems affecting myotendinous junctions and synovial sheaths in particular. Shockwave therapy can be used to treat chronic pain and to increase flexibility in areas of scar tissue. The treatment also invigorates the metabolism in the injured area. Shockwave therapy is short and intensive.

Shockwave therapy is an effective alternative to cortisone and surgical procedures in the treatment of chronic pain.



## Activomed

The Activomed pulsed electromagnetic therapy rug combines a pulsing magnetic field with massage therapy. The rug treats the horse from the muscles in the hind-quarters to the top of the neck.

The Activomed therapy rug can be used for e.g. muscle tightness, muscle strains, soft tissue injuries, inflammation in the spine and joints, tendon injuries and strains, and as a supportive treatment for poorly healing wounds.

Pulsed electromagnetic therapy is a safe type of physical treatment without any side effects.

Activomed therapy affects vasodilation in the large blood vessels and capillaries and stimulates the metabolism. The treatment can be used as a supportive measure before or after performance.

# Clinical examination equipment




#### X-ray imaging

Our equipment can take the most common x-rays of the feet and back, plus carry out abdominal radiography to check for sand accumulation.

X-ray imaging can be used to investigate skeletal issues and to monitor on-site how bone injuries are healing. Our equipment can take the most common x-rays of the feet and back, plus carry out abdominal radiography to check for sand accumulation.

We send follow-up x-ray images to the treating veterinarian or farrier. The images are interpreted by a veterinarian.



#### **Blood tests**

Vets interpret blood tests to ascertain e.g. inflammation and to check for the values that most commonly indicate health complaints. Ask our customer services for more information!

# Bemer physical vascular therapy



The Bemer therapy blanket can treat large areas on the horse's body.

The Bemer therapy device improves circulation in the large and small blood vessels and supports the body's own healing processes. The Bemer therapy blanket can treat large areas on the horse's body.

The Bemer therapy device improves circulation in the small and extremely small blood vessels by means of electromagnetic signals and thereby supports the body's own healing processes.

The device supports the body's immune system. Bemer therapy affects injury healing, recovery, and regeneration processes. Reduces inflammation and susceptibility to inflammation.

Bemer can be used for e.g. muscle and tendon injuries, joint complaints, scar tissue, wound healing processes, and to improve performance. In addition to the therapy blanket, there is also a neck applicator and cuffs.
